Dear Parents,

We hope that you have had a relaxing Easter and the children are reinvigorated and ready for our last term in Year 6. With so much to fit in, these weeks promise to be busy but exciting as we undertake our final topics and preparations before the children's transition onto secondary school. This term, the children will be undertaking their end of Key Stage Assessments, rehearsing and performing our year group play, learning important safety skills during the 'Think Safe' event and many other activities such as using their entrepreneurial talents in teams within the Fiver Challenge.

Our overarching themes this term are **Yateley** followed by **Crime and Punishment**. Within these topics, we will be learning about local history and using our map skills to read and create maps of Yateley. We will explore how punishments for crimes have changed throughout different periods in history. During these units, the children will be partaking in a variety of cross-curricular learning such as our DT project (moving shop windows), exploring the concept of justice in RE and discovering British Rules and Laws through PSHE.


