- Ensure that my child's hair is tied back if long enough to do so
- Ensure that my child does not wear any jewellery other than a watch and/or a pair of plain, small stud earrings
- Not take holidays or days out in term time in order to minimise the disruption to the education of my child and the children in their class
- Support the school's aims and values including the school's Respect Charter and Behaviour Policy
- Support my child in their learning, and ensure their home learning is completed including reading, spelling and mental maths fluency practise
- Attend open evenings, workshops and discussions about my child's learning or behaviour
- Work in partnership with the school and raise any concerns appropriately with a member of school staff, or Governing Body, and not in a public domain eg. via social media
- Keep the school informed about anything which might affect my child's learning or behaviour
