

Examples of each reading destination:

Non-fiction books: These are 'fact' books and are sometimes referred to as information books. Examples include: Look inside...SPACE	Classic texts: Classic texts are well-known novels that are noted as exemplary examples that stand the 'test of time' e.g. Black Beauty.
Poetry books: There are so many different poems to read and enjoy. An example of a poetry book is '100 Brilliant Poems'.	Fantasy books: These books include magic and make-believe settings or characters. An example of this is Harry Potter.
Biographical books: Biographies are texts that explain about the life or an event of a person/people e.g. 'Fantastically Great Women Who Changed the World'.	Mystery books: Mystery books have a crime to solve and often have a detective character. Examples include: 'Famous Five' and 'Cream Buns and Crime'.
