Please note that children will be expected to sit quietly during the show to ensure everyone is able to enjoy the event.

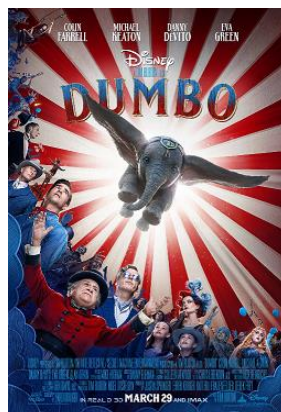
