Dear Parents,

As part of our Science curriculum, Year 5 have begun learning about Space. As the half term progresses, children will be learning about the stars, planets and galaxies. In order to 'bring to life' our study of Space, we would like to provide a unique opportunity for Year 5 to attend a day visit to Winchester Science Centre and Planetarium on Friday 15th November.

The children will begin their day with Destination Space - an hour long workshop. With the aim to inspire future generations of scientists, the Science Centre has partnered up with the UK Space Agency to offer the Destination Space Workshop which 'recruits' and 'trains' the next generation of space scientists. We will learn some of the key skills needed to be not only an astronaut, but a scientist or engineer working in the space industry. Through problem-solving activities and experiments, pupils also get a chance to use their communication, mathematical and team-working skills to control a robot-arm and investigate two of the problems facing astronauts in space; floating liquids and the effects of a vacuum!

We will then explore the Science Centre through the hands on exhibits to revise and explore key concepts in our Science curriculum.

After lunch we will experience a live planetarium show. The show starts with a look at the night sky, with a focus on any planets currently visible. Then the planetarium takes off from Earth, and after a look back at our home world, travels in one seamless flight out to the edges of the Solar System to look back at the orbits of the planets before flying to visit each in turn. The content of the show varies in response to new discoveries and topical news items, but may include the chance to peek through Venus' clouds using radar; visit the Curiosity Rover on the surface of Mars; see eclipses on Jupiter or to fly through Saturn's rings. Every show is a little different as the presenter navigates an accurate 3-dimension model of the Universe in real-time. The show is finally followed by a question and answer session.

The *Planet Show* is a highly effective way to challenge misconceptions created by the distorted scales used in other media: pupils get an idea of how huge those distances really are compared to the sizes of the planets.


