The Remembrance Day Service will be held at St. Swithun's Church on Sunday 10th November. We would like the children attending to be dressed in school uniform and to meet myself and other Westfields Junior School staff members in the Church car park by 2pm. After the service has finished, we will parade to the Green, by the Dog and Partridge, for a short service and the wreath laying ceremony which should finish at around 3.45pm.

Parents are being asked to either line the route or follow on at the end of the Parade, but not join in the actual parade. On conclusion of the service, arrangements will need to be made for the children to be collected from the War Memorial.

We feel that it is important for the children to understand the sacrifices people made during the World Wars and other conflicts.
