Mill Rythe Activity Village:

- Mill Rythe is situated on Hayling Island.
- It looks out onto Chichester Harbour which is an area of outstanding beauty.
- The village has purpose-built climbing towers, outdoor and indoor heated swimming pools, on-site lake, sports fields, an indoor performance hall and is in walking distance to the beach.



Location:



It takes approximately 1 hour and 20 minutes to drive to Mill Rythe Activity Village from Yateley.



Departure from school at approximately 9am on the Monday morning.
Arrival home at approximately 3pm on the Friday afternoon.

About JCA:



- Mill Rythe Activity Village is run by JCA. They have in excess of 20 years experience in providing adventures for children.
- They offer action packed timetables with trained instructors.
- Instructors and school staff remain with their group for activities and meal times throughout the residential to ensure consistency and build confidence.

Safety and Security:

- All groups are accommodated in purpose-built blocks set within the grounds of Mill Rythe.
- The JCA team are on call 24 hours a day to support schools during their stay on site.
- All instructors are trained to lead land-based activities and water based activities are led by specialist watersports instructors.
- The entrance is secure and manned 24 hours a day.



Safety and Security:

- Children are in activity groups of up to 12. Each group has a leader from Westfields and a JCA instructor.
- If your child requires any medicines, there are designated members of school staff to organise and administer this.
- All school staff are available at any time (day or night) during the residential to support and care for your children.



Accommodation:



- The children are accommodated in 1-2 bedroom heated chalets, which can sleep up to 5 people.
- Each chalet houses an en-suite shower or bath and is fitted with central heating.
- Rooms are maintained by a team of housekeepers ensuring they are clean and tidy.

Food/Meal times:

- Mill Rythe provide three healthy, balanced and high-energy meals each day.
- There are a variety of options available which includes hot and cold food as well as puddings!
- Vegetarian options are available and special dietary requirements are catered for.



Activities:

There are a wide range of activities available including:

- abseiling & climbing
- high ropes (crate stack, gladiator challenge, high all aboard, high see-saw, Jacob's ladder, trapeze & traversing elements)
- archery
- campfire
- canoeing & kayaking
- dance mania
